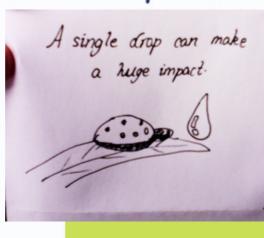


6: 6 stages of water, droplet, puddle, pond, river, ocean
